Doctrinal Transformation



Background: Observations from deployments in support of OEF and OIF dictate the need to establish CONOPS doctrine, policy and procedures. Significant, is the need for a feeding standard/policy that goes beyond the current “Army Field Feeding Policy” and “Army Family of Rations.”

“Develop a CONOPS feeding standard and policy that commanders will support”

Doctrinal Transformation



Army Field Feeding Standard/Policy:

Three quality meals per day with the capability to distribute, prepare and serve at least one A-Ration meal per day (METT-TC dependant)

Approved 2 June 1992

Remains in existence today



- 21 Day Line Item A-Ration Menus

□ Line Item A Options

- **UGR-A Short Order Supplemental Menu**
 - **Enhances the UGR-A with S/O menu choices**
 - **Easy to prepare highly accepted menu items**
 - **Breakfast**: Burritos, hot sandwiches, muffins, French toast sticks, hash browns, etc
 - **Lunch/Dinner**: burgers, franks, hot sandwiches, pizza, calzone, chicken tenders/wings, ribs & chicken, bakeable fries & onion rings
 - **Desserts**: cakes, pies, cookies and ice cream
 - **Electronic ordering format**


Line Item A Option

▪ Army 21-Day CONOPS Menu

- Standardized menu platform for sustained deployments in well protected and resourced environments
- Force provider or LOGCAP contract required
- Provides desired menu choices and dining atmosphere (non-tactical)

Transition to line item A's must be approved by HQDA IAW DA PAM 30-22 and all supporting requirements, i.e. personnel, equipment, refrigeration, storage, transportation, SPV platform must be rated green.

□ Conclusion: Transformation to CONOPS Feeding Standard/Policy coupled with implementation of CONOPS Menu is expected to :

- **Standardize CONOPS subsistence support**
- **Facilitate strategic planning for CONOPS**
- **Improve SPV fill rates**
- **Meet commander and customer expectations**
