 - ❖ **RECOMMENDED CONTRACTING AND GARRISON EQUIPMENT SPECIALISTS TO IMA**
 - ❖ **1 SME FROM EACH MACOM TRANSFERS TO REGION**
 - ❖ **4 CONUS/3OCONUS REGIONAL OFFICES**
 - ❖ **CHANGE TRANSPARENT AT INSTALLATION LEVEL**
 - ❖ **BASEOPS (F ACCT FUNDING) THRU REGION**
 - ❖ **NOT MACOM BEGINNING 1 OCT 02**



BSB Provides

- Company Level Unit Configured Loads of MREs only until augmented
- Trans Platoon delivers MREs every 2-3 days
- Food Service must be operational by D+20

BSB Capability

General Supply Section

- Receives, stores, and issues up to 35 STs total per day of classes I, II, III, IV, and VII.
- Consists of 8 92As, 3 MTVs, 2 Atlas Forklifts, & 2 ISU 90s

13.8 STs



TRANSFORMATION FIELD FEEDING



What's Different

- ➔ No organic cooks
- ➔ Augmentation, military or other, arrives and is operational by D+20

Risks

- ✓ UCLs pushed every 2 days
- ✓ Availability of augmentation for food service


Enablers

- ✓ Mounted Water Ration Heater (IAV ORD)
- ✓ Unitized Group Rations
- ✓ Containerized Kitchen (FUE Jan 02)
- ✓ Multi-Temperature Refrigerated Container System (FUE Aug 05)

- ➔ Identify changes in Army Field Feeding Policy as a result of transformation



- ❖ MUST IMPLEMENT OPRAT FORECASTING

❖ BASE OPERATIONS (F ACCOUNT)


- ❖ EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ FY03 (PB 03): \$240.7M


