

SIGNIFICANCE OF INSIGNIA

PHILIP A. CONNELLY AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN ARMY FOOD SERVICE

A disc with a narrow border bearing a sun in splendor of thirteen straight rays between thirteen five-pointed stars, the sun divided by a wavy band and crossed vertically by a stylish ear of wheat, all within a continuous scroll enarched convex at top and concave at base reversed and perpendicular at each side, lined with three crescents conjoined points inward and bearing the inscription at top "Philip A. Connelly Award" and in base "Excellence in Army Food Service."

The thirteen stars represent the United States, and the sun, as a symbol of provider, intelligence and order, denotes the overall mission of the Army Food Service Program and also refers to its worldwide scope of operation. The wavy band simulates flowing water and with the sun alludes to the continuing rejuvenation and to the cleanliness aspects of the unit's program, while the wheat symbolizes bread, the staff of life. The crescent, used as a mark on Army rations during the last century, relates to subsistence. The "Circle" and the thirteen five-pointed stars simulate the rim of the wheel of the insignia of branch, Quartermaster Corps, the thirteen rays being suggestive of the spokes.

Only the most dedicated food service professionals can earn the prestigious certification, and successful applicants proudly add CFE following their names as a sign of their achievement, knowledge, and industry leadership.

Military Food Service Evaluation

IFSEA's responsibility to encourage excellence in food service in all walks of the industry is evidenced by its sponsorship of the military awards programs. Under sponsorship provisions, IFSEA members are selected to chair each of the military evaluation committees charged to select the winners and runners up of respective Service competitive programs.

Professionalism Begins with Youth

Encouragement of food service careers is a high priority of IFSEA. Over the past 12 years, IFSEA's scholarship programs have provided in excess of \$1 million in financial assistance to qualified food service students.

Rewards for Professional Achievement

IFSEA recognizes outstanding achievement through presentation of awards. Philip A. Connelly Awards Program
for Excellence in Army Food Service

- ESTABLISHED** in March 1968 to recognize excellence in Army Food Service.

- IFSEA provides the awards; host awards recipients at annual conference; and provides civilian executives to chair committees in conduct of worldwide evaluation.
- Army administers program and awards ceremonies; provides military members on evaluation committees; and funds all program costs other than the Connelly trophies and IFSEA evaluator per diem.
- CATEGORIES** Small Dining Facilities - Serve 400 or less per meal Large Dining Facilities - Serve 401 or more per meal Active Army Field Kitchens - Feeding in field operations National Guard Field Kitchens - Feeding in field operations Army Reserve Field Kitchens - Feeding in field operations
- COMPETITION** multi-level, starting at Battalion/Brigade. Major Army Commands submit nominee finalists for all categories, to Army Center of Excellence, Subsistence, U.S. Army Quartermaster Center and School (USAQMC&S), for DA evaluation.

- WINNERS** first and second place winners selected from major command finalists, each category. DA evaluation conducted September - December, annually; winners announced in a DA message release, per directive of Commanding General of QMC&S.

Recognition throughout Army for Significant Accomplishment

The Connelly Awards Program has had a major impact on the degree of professionalism now associated with Army Food Service. The Program's fringe benefits have caused specific improvements in the quality of food and food service provided the soldier. Examples of this are:

Exposure of Army Personnel to Civilian Industry Expertise:

Occurs during contact with civilian evaluators and executives at IFSEA conferences -- experiences awaken new sense of personal responsibility for professional development. Scholarships for training with industry add even greater impetus to this item as an invaluable benefit.

Personal Challenge to Individual Soldiers:

A result in proliferation of outstanding effort -- one individual inspires another to seek satisfaction of on-the-job excellence.

Army-Industry Interface in innovative Planning and Training:

Exchange of information at conferences, between civilian evaluators and Army personnel in the facilities and during periods of training provided award winners help ensure conformity with state-of-the art of the profession. Serves as sounding board for development of new trends/procedures in Army operations.

Increased Public Awareness of Army Food Service:

Dispels negative WWII image of untrained, unmotivated personnel, working in unmodernized, poorly managed facilities; projects positive image of professional corps under development -- with training objectives and orderly management/organization alignment.

Increased attention from public arena also causes increased command interest in local programs and results in improved operations.

Specialized Training Provided Competition Winners/Selected Program Participants:

Training awards bring new inspiration, personal motivation, and improved techniques into Army food operations.

Competition Perpetuates Sense of Prestige and Dignity:

Personal and group accomplishments instill greater pride in food service workers for themselves and their profession.

The Connelly competition is comprised of five categories, two categories for active duty garrison and three for field feeding. The active duty garrison categories are: small dining facilities (capacity of 400 or less) and large dining facilities (capacity of 401 or more). Dining facility design capacity as reported on the DA form 4945, column f, dining facility modernization plan development is used to determine active small and large dining facilities.

The three field feeding categories are: Active Army field kitchens (field food service operations which are an organic element to and provide food service to a unit in the field) and Reserve Component units representing the Army National Guard and the Army Reserve.

In the active Army competition, major commands conduct multi-level competitive activities from March through June with each ultimately choosing one DA finalist in each of the three categories mentioned above, with the exception of U.S. Army Forces Command, who gets three active Army field representatives. Contract operated facilities are included in the garrison competition.

The Army Center of Excellence, Subsistence, U.S. Army Quartermaster Center and School, dedicates the entire year to planning and coordinating the DA Philip A. Connelly Awards Program for Excellence in Army Food Service. The first step in the process begins in the June through August time frame and consists of the nomination of finalists units by the major Army commands to the Quartermaster Center and School and ultimately to the development and planning of the Connelly Awards Ceremony.

In October - December, separate Department of the Army evaluation committees select a winner and runner-up unit in each of the five categories. Evaluation committees are comprised of representatives of IFSEA and the U.S. Army Quartermaster Center and School.

The garrison evaluation process encompasses two complete meals, consecutively. All facets of the operation are examined during this period, with the greatest emphasis placed on food quality and customer acceptance. In the field kitchen category, only the lunch meal will be evaluated, the evaluation process encompasses all facets of preparing and serving food in the field.

The Quartermaster Center and School and IFSEA provide evaluators for the DA phase of the Reserve Component competition. A winner and runner-up unit is selected in each of the two categories.

WIDESPREAD RECOGNITION: Selected representatives of both winning and runner-up units in the competition are hosted as guests of honor at the weeklong food education conference of IFSEA. There, they are honored in many festivities, featured in special awards ceremonies, and interviewed by press and television media.

TROPHIES: At the annual Connelly Awards Ceremony, winning units in all five categories receive large silver bowl trophies. Runner-up units in the five categories receive handsome plaques.

CERTIFICATES: Both the Army and IFSEA provide Certificates of Recognition to all members of finalist food service staffs.

1994 - The Memorandum of Understanding changed to read: officers at the rank of colonel and senior noncommissioned officers, in the position of command sergeant major may be designated by the major command to accept awards in the event, a general officer is not available.

1995 - The United States Coast Guard presented their Excellence in Food Service Awards for the first time in conjunction with the Connelly ceremony. The establishing of permanent awards sites was approved with east/west coast sites to be determined.
