

Role as Resource Provider

- The G-4 chairs the Sustaining Program Evaluation Group (PEG)
the PEG is the gateway to the POM process
- Subsistence resources are found in three PEGs:
 - Sustaining PEG funds
 - ✓ Army Center of Excellence, Subsistence at Fort Lee
 - ✓ DoD Combat Feeding Program at Natick the Army
 - ✓ Food Management Information System (AFMIS)
 - Installations PEG funds
 - ✓ TISAs
 - ✓ Installation Dining Facilities, and equipment/décor items for MCA contract dining facilities
 - Manning PEG funds
 - ✓ subsistence – garrison meals, operational rations, and augmentation rations

Installation Management Agency (IMA)



HQDA (G-4) / MACOMs / IMA / ACES

- Work garrison feeding program issues
- Execute the Army Food Program

G-4 / ACES retain policy responsibility for both garrison and tactical/field feeding

Change 1 to AR 30-22

- Publication of “rules of the road” for all organizations having shared food program responsibilities
- Connelly Awards Program Revisions
- Contingency Operations to include bottled water
