

“The 600 Pound Gorilla”

(a subsistence specific allotment)

- **Beginning 1 Oct 2005, the subsistence open allotment for SIK will be replaced by a specific (closed) allotment.**
- **Emerging Methodology: Quarterly funding limits provided to IMA by Regions equal to region’s installations’ requirements.**
 - Garrison dining
 - Operational rations
 - Augmentation rations (catered meals, KATUSA kits, host nation meals)
- **Monthly execution management**



Installation Requirements

Determination (*Food for Thought*)

- **Some piece parts of an installation's requirements:**
 - What is SIK / meal card population? Proper absentee rate?
 - What is BDFFA level? How to factor monthly changes?
 - Feed garrison cash customers? BDFFA vs. DoD rate?
 - ARNG, USAR, common service, GWOT meals?
 - How to handle or forecast deployments?
 - What number of Soldiers to be fed in field? How long? Breakdown by officer and enlisted; BAS and SIK?
 - Which operational ration? What supplements?
 - Number and cost of true catered meals? What cash collection rate? KATUSA/host nation requirement?
- **And more...**

- New Quality of Life Initiatives/New Barracks/Relocation of Forces.....Will Drive Feeding Changes
- We Have an Obligation to the BAS Soldier...Not Civilians
