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# AFMIS

- Mission
  - Provides automated support to control the management and operation of the Army's worldwide food service program. AFMIS provides the users with the capability to order, receipt, inventory, and invoice Class I supplies to include field rations. AFMIS supports the operation of Dining Facilities for Menu Planning, Production and Recipe Management, Automated Head Count, labor scheduling, cash collection, and equipment replacement.

# AFMIS

- Modernization Approach
  - Phase I Replace 3B2 Architecture with Intel-Based SCO Server
  - Phase II Provide AHC/A La Carte Interface
  - Phase III Web-based Headquarters Reporting
  - Phase IV AFMIS Web-Based Software/Server Consolidation

# AFMIS Web

- Purpose

- Centralizes the Army Food Program data into one central repository. Provides the flexibility to execute on various levels defined by the AFMIS community. Eliminates the batch processing and provides for a more user friendly interface. Meets DoD AKM goal to have software developed as web enabled or web based.

# AFMIS Web

- Savings
  - Reduces AFMIS “footprint” on the Army’s network
    - Eliminates the need for 55 installation servers
    - Eliminates the need for 350 dining facilities Back-Office-Servers (BOS)
  - Minimizes the local SA duties
  - Minimizes installations’ security requirements
  - Minimizes SW releases’ costs/installation
  - Reduced customer assistance

Bottom Line – It saves the Army \$

  - Awaiting Deployment of Additional Servers

# AFMIS Web Deployment

- Preparation Legacy AFMIS
  - Requires Port 22
  - Passwords afmis and root
  - Conversion Scripts Loaded to Site
  - Data Validation
    - Edits.out
    - Reports.out

# Legacy AFMIS Conversion

- Week Before Go Live
  - Legacy Installation Data Locked
  - Site Established on Web
  - Non-Purchased Ingredients loaded
  - STORES Catalog loaded
  - Master Item File Conversion
  - Recipe Conversion
  - Master Menu Conversion
  - Field Menu Recaps Conversion

# Legacy AFMIS Conversion

- Week Before Go Live (Cont.)
  - Customer Data Entered
    - Requires UIC
    - Reimbursable Customers Require DODAAC, APC, & FSN
  - Building Data Conversion
  - Import Equipment Data
  - Production Template Conversion

# Legacy AFMIS Conversion

- Week Go Live
  - Analysts on site
  - Legacy Processing Terminates
    - Sequence and Instructions Coordinated With Site
    - Site should Plan to be Manual One Day
  - EOD / DSS Feed Executed
  - Final Legacy Data Extracted

- Week Go Live (Cont.)
  - Production Schedules Conversion
  - Headcount Conversion
  - Import Legacy STORES Orders
  - Import Legacy Issues
  - Account Status Conversion
  - Balance-on-hand Conversion

# Background

- **AOR Issues**

- No automation tools in dining facilities, Troop Issue and Installation Food Program Managers
- No management oversight on inventory
- No audit trail on financial obligations and accruals
- No accurate headcount of who's subsisting in dining facilities

- **Why AOR?**

- Requested by Deputy Undersecretary of the Army
- 82% Subsistence \$ expended w/o automation and management oversight

    - Two DODAACS versus Eight or More
  - Number of databases to Build to Support
  - Customer Relationship to Site

  - Week 1 Kuwait & Qatar 3 Sessions
  - Week 2-3 Iraq 6 Sessions
  - Week 3-4 Afghanistan 4 Sessions
  - Total of 260 personnel trained
- “Swipe & Go”
  - 3rd Qtr 08
    - Development of new interface
    - Training and deployment of HW
