



Definition of a Warrant Officer

Warrant Officers are **innovative integrators of emerging technologies**, dynamic teachers, confident war-fighters and developers of specialized teams of Soldiers. They support a wide range of Army missions throughout their career.”

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

Opportunities as a Warrant Officer



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Warrant Officer MOS Comparison




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

Warrant Officer Promotions




TIG – Time in Grade

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

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Quartermaster Warrant Officers

➤ **920A Property Accountability Technician: Serves a Property Book Officers at Divisions, Brigades, Groups, Battalions, and separate TDA activities**



➤ **920B Supply Systems Technician: Serves as Accountable Officers at the Supply Support Activity & Direct Support Unit levels**




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Quartermaster Warrant Officers

- **921A Airdrop Systems Technician:**
Provides airborne and airdrop operations technical guidance to commanders and staff activities
- **922A Food Service Technician:**
Coordinates and supervises the food service program for installations, commands, and organizations in both garrison and field environments



Quartermaster Warrant Officers

➤ *923A Petroleum Systems Technician:*

The new Quartermaster Warrant Officer specialty started in 2006. A staff position requiring petroleum expertise. They determine requirements for bulk fuel and packaged petroleum products. Storage space and fuel systems.

Predetermination Process and Prerequisites

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PDP Process

- **Not a board action or selection process**
- **Certifies that the Soldier meets the minimum criteria**
- **Non-competitive**
- **Does not mean that the Soldier is the best fit**



PDP Process

- **Reviewed by the proponent and an SME**
- **If incomplete goes to pending file**
- **Decision by Proponent is reviewed by Deputy Chief, Office of the Quartermaster General**
- **Forwarded to Chief, Office of the Quartermaster General for review and signature**
- **Memo sent to NGB, Strength Manager, RTD**



Army Prerequisites

- **US citizen**
- **GT score - 110 or higher**
- **High school graduate (or GED)**
- **Have a **secret** security clearance (interim to apply)**
- **Pass the standard 3-event APFT (Exception to Policy)**
 - **Alternate Events Count**
- **Meet Height/Weight Standards**
- **Pass appointment physical exam (Not required for ARNG for Predetermination Packet)**

These are mandatory Army Prerequisites



Quartermaster Prerequisites

- **E-5 or higher (Except 921A – E-6)**
 - **ARNG E-4**
- **Letter of recommendation from a Senior Warrant Officer holding the appropriate MOS**
- **Letters of recommendation from company and battalion/brigade commander**
- **Six credit hours of college level English**
- **Outstanding duty performance in feeder MOS**



MOS Specific

- **MOS 920A – Property Accountability Technician**
 - **Have 5 years experience in MOS 92Y/68J**
- **MOS 920B – Supply Systems Technician**
 - **Have 5 years experience in MOS 92A**
- **MOS 921A – Airdrop Systems Technician**
 - **SSG or above w/8 yrs experience in MOS 92R**
 - **Be a BNCOC graduate**
 - **Jumpmaster qualified and be rated a Senior/Master Parachutist**
 - **Have completed the Airdrop Load Inspectors Course**
 - **Have documented a minimum of two years experience supervising operations in a packing shed, repair shop, cargo airdrop facility, or storage warehouse**

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MOS Specific (con't)

- **MOS 922A – Food Service Technician**
 - **Have 5 years documented experience in MOS 92G/68M**
 - **Have documented a minimum of two years supervising personnel (first Cook/Shift Leader in garrison and field operations)**
- **MOS 923A – Petroleum Systems Technician**
 - **Have 5 years documented experience serving as a Fuel Handler in MOS 92F, 92L or 92W**
 - **Have three (3) hours of a series 100 Basic College Mathematics Course**
 - **Does not require a letter of recommendation from a senior 923A**



Prerequisite Discussion

- **Proof of Citizenship**
 - **DA Form 61**
 - **Stated on Security Clearance**

- **High School Graduate**
 - **DA Form 61**
 - **High School Diploma**

- **GT Score**
 - **ERB**
 - **DA 2-1**
 - **Memo from unit**
 - **Typed Entry**
 - **No Line Outs**



Prerequisite Discussion

- **Army Physical Fitness Test**
 - **DA 705 or DA 61**
 - **Request for Waivers are accepted**
 - **ARNG Waivers are approved prior to packet review**
 - **Soldier must be able to do 10K Road March with 40 LB Pack**
 - **Strongly recommend use of USAREC 1932 or equivalent**

- **Security Clearance**
 - **Must have a Secret prior to school attendance**
 - **Can apply with an Interim Secret**
 - **JPAS printout or letter from Security Manager**

- **Height/Weight Standards**
 - **DA 705**
 - **Body Fat Worksheet**



Prerequisite Discussion

➤ **Appointment Physical**

- **Not required for predetermination for ARNG candidates**
- **Should be included if an APFT waiver is requested**

➤ **Grade Requirement**

- **All MOSs but 921A – E-4 (ARNG only)**
- **921A – Must be E-6**

➤ **Letters of Recommendation**

- **Should be quantitative**
- **Do not use same letter for different command levels**
- **Separate letters from each command level**
 - **No “Line Through” endorsements**
- **Additional letters for E-4s**
 - **No NCOERs**



Prerequisite Discussion

- **Letters of Recommendation (con't)**
 - **Chain of Command Letters**
 - Need two levels
 - Company Commander and BN/BDE Commander or equivalent
 - **Senior Warrant Letter**
 - MOS specific
 - CW3 or above
 - Not required for MOS 923A
 - **Signatures**
 - All Letters of Recommendation must be signed (no //s//)
 - Signed “For” takes away from the credibility of the letter
- **College Courses**
 - All references to degrees have been removed from prereqs
 - **English (6 credit hours – All QMWO MOSs)**
 - Must be writing based
 - Will waive 3 credit hours if Soldier has 3 and is enrolled in course



Prerequisite Discussion

- **College Courses (con't)**
 - **Math (3 credit hours – MOS 923A)**
 - Any 100 series college math (Algebra based)
 - Used for hydraulics and fluid dynamics
 - Will not waive

Prerequisite Discussion

- **NCO Evaluation Reports**
 - **Need all of them**
 - **Somewhat liberal in the interpretation**
 - **Promote Ahead of Peers – Fully Qualified??**
 - **In general ARNG tends to under inflate NCOERs**

- **Experience**
 - **Relatively recent – within the last 8 to 10 years**
 - **Deployments**
 - **Will add 6 to 8 months/year if Soldier worked in MOS**
 - **Civilian Experience**
 - **Must have some military experience**
 - **Civilian experience must be closely related**
 - **Miltech experience in comparable job counts the as the same**



Special Situations

- **Reclassification of Warrant Officers**
 - **Not situational – Based on qualifications**
 - All the Army owes you is a paycheck
 - **Packet similar to accession packet**
 - **Must have documented experience in new MOS**
 - Additional duties
 - Miltech experience
 - Does not have to be 5 years

- **Officer to Warrant Officer**
 - **Again – Not situational – Based on qualifications**
 - We are not a retention program
 - **Documented experience – depth of knowledge not breadth**
 - **Very few are approved**



General Comments

➤ **Biographical Summary**

- **Direct reflection of the Soldier**
- **Assignments/School must be validated on official records**
- **Must be comprehensive and complete**
- **Attention to detail**

➤ **Requests for Information**

- **Proper spelling and grammar**
- **Military Courtesy**

I am interested in applying. Where do I start. *E-Mailed from AOL address*

➤ **Packet is the Soldier's responsibility**

- **Strength Manager/Special Mission Recruiter is an enabler**
