The *personal statement*, in no more than 500 words, is your opportunity to sell yourself in the application and selection process. It contains, but is not limited to, three categories:

1. What are your career goals? What personal characteristics (integrity, compassion, and/or persistence) do you possess that would improve your prospects for success as an Enlisted Aide? Demonstrate or document that you have the character traits required to serve as an Enlisted Aide.
2. Culinary experience. Explain your qualifications and passion for cooking and the ability to plan and perform events for senior leaders such as experience, training, and/or any other functions/events that will highlight your culinary skills; what's special, unique, distinctive, and/or impressive about you and your military career.
3. What details of your personal, professional, history, people and/or events have shaped you or influenced your goals that might help the selection and nomination panel better understand you or help set you apart from other applicants?
