

Food Issues We Have to Deal With

- 1. Class 1, Field Feeding Support to the Modular/Future Force**
 - **Force Structure; Doctrine; Rations & Equipment**
 - **Issue: What Capability Gaps Exist regarding Class 1 and Field Feeding Support**
 - **Short Term Resolution: Approved AR 5-5 Study**



Food Issues We Have to Deal With

2. Role & Function of an Appropriated Dining Facility

- **New Barracks Designs w. Kitchens.....Contemplating possible privatization**

Issue: Is Traditional Feeding in our DFACs still the wave of the future? Where should we be heading?



Food Issues We Have to Deal With

3. Contingency Feeding

- **LOGCAP Costs.....Food Costs almost \$2B a year**

Issue: Is the benefit to morale worth the cost to provide a menu robust beyond any expectation that you would find anywhere else in the Army or on the outside? Is there any turning back? What are the implications to all our other feeding?


4. DFAC Contracting

- **Very expensive; IMA needs to cut costs**
