We are withdrawing only these code dates of product because the product does not meet our quality standards and we can not rule out the possibility that some packages may contain small pieces of metal. The quality error was limited in scope and the company took immediate steps to prevent a recurrence. We anticipate no further disruption in product shipments to customers.

No other Nabisco Chips Ahoy! products are impacted by this withdrawal.

Our direct store delivery sales force is removing the product with the withdrawn code dates from store shelves where it was distributed. No action is required on the part of our customers.
