MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Change to AR 30-22 Par 4-2 Army Policy for Field Feeding

1. This policy change directs all units to utilize the entire family of rations while performing a wartime mission which will result in our manufacturing partners accommodating our wartime needs with a warm ration base.
2. The current policy as prescribed in the AR 30-22 left too much room for interpretation and resulted in UGR-Heat and Serve (H/S) rations being underutilized.
3. A summary of agreed upon changes to AR 30-22 para 4-2 are listed below:
 - a. 4-2(C)- Any field training exercise more than three days must establish a field account.
 - b. 4-2(C)- When using group rations, at least 1 meal per day must be the UGR-H&S rotating between Breakfast and Lunch/Dinner each day. Exercises exceeding 14 days are authorized a UGR/A-M-UGR/A mix starting on day 15.
 - c. 4-2(D) – Add "(in accordance with AR 600-38, Chapter 4)"
 - d. All changes are effective 1 July 2013 and will be adjusted in the next revision of AR 30-22.
