

## QUARTERMASTER CORPS MISSION STATEMENT



**The Quartermaster Corps** – Logistics Warriors providing focused logistics support to sustain America's Army in victory today and into the 21st Century.

Provide For:

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## CMF 92 UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS



- **Leadership** - Positions are critical in the development of NCOs.
  - NCOs in leadership positions have the fortitude to lead Soldiers by accepting the responsibility to take care of Soldiers as well as themselves.
  - Leadership positions require great knowledge of Warrior Tasks and Battle Drills that will enhance survivability on the battlefield.
  - There are many leadership positions that are non-traditional, but have a high level of responsibility for both personnel and equipment sometimes exceeding the responsibility level of a Platoon Sergeant.



# AUTOMATED LOGISTICAL SPECIALIST 92A



**Major duties:** The Automated Logistical NCO major duties include, ensuring that inventories and location surveys are performed in accordance with established procedures; instruct warehouse personnel in loading, unloading and selection of stock and storage areas; recommend additions and deletions to authorized stockage lists (ASL); review requests for major and controlled items; perform financial management functions; perform functions to include stock replenishment, price changes, inventories and stock receipts. Some key duties for Soldiers serving in the Operating/Modular Force include: First Sergeant, Operations NCO, Support Operations NCO, Procurement NCO and CSSAMO NCO. Key duties in the Generating Force include: Instructor, Writer, Personnel Proponent NCO and Professional Development NCO (HRC).


## SPECIAL MOS CONSIDERATIONS 92A



- MOSs 92A and 92Y merge at E9 to become MOS 92Z
- Leadership positions are generally found in the Forward Support Companies (FSC), and Distribution Companies (DC) within Sustainment Brigades
- All Quartermaster MOSs are open to male and female Soldiers; however, DCPC coding of positions precludes assignment of females to certain combat arms units
- Soldiers within MOS are required to perform a broad spectrum of challenging duties such as CSSAMO and STAMIS NCOIC which have significant responsibility

# PETROLEUM SUPPLY SPECIALIST 92F



**Major duties:** The Petroleum Supply NCO major duties include: spot checking work quality; assuring adherence to safety procedures; supervises aircraft refueling and defueling operations; directs reclamation and disposition for petroleum products and assigns duties to junior enlisted Petroleum Supply Specialists. Plans and organizes petroleum laboratory activities and supervises within the Class III arena. Supervises quality surveillance programs ensuring adherence with environmental standards. Some key duties for Soldiers serving in the Operating/Modular Force include: First Sergeant, Operations NCO, Support Operations NCO and Petroleum/Water Supply NCOIC. Key duties in the Generating Force include: Chief, Instructor/Writer, Personnel Proponent NCO, Professional Development NCO (HRC), Equal Opportunity Advisor and Inspector General NCO.














- MOSs 92A and 92Y merge at E9 to become MOS 92Z
