

U.S. Army Waiver Packets For Active Duty Enlisted Soldiers



- 1.) All Prior Service Soldiers **MUST** go through United States Army Recruiting Command Personnel Policy and Readiness Division for waiver requests.
- 2.) Memorandum: From Station Commander on Soldiers behalf.
 - MEMORANDUM FOR Enlisted Proponent, Office of the Quartermaster General, US Army Quartermaster School, Fort Lee, Virginia 23801.
- 3.) DD 214 showing Record of Prior Service:
 - Primary Specialty in line 11 must be legible
- 4.) Recent DD Form 2808 Medical Evaluation (Physical) Showing:
 - Color Vision
 - PULHES
- 5.) REDD Report
 - Must be able to read ASVAB Scores with the date the Soldier took the test.
- 7.) **MOS 92Y**: If the Soldier is requesting MOS 92Y background check must be submitted
- 8.) Army Civilian Acquired Skills Program (ACASP): Any documents that may include certificates, transcripts, diplomas, union cards, or employment records showing the period of actual work experience, training received, degree of proficiency attained, and a summary of duties and training in a civilian-acquired skill. (REF: AR 600-210) Soldier must submit certified copies. QM MOS that qualified for ACASP:
 - 92G, 92L, 92M, 92S, 92W
- 9.) **DO NOT highlight** anything on the documents that are scanned!
